Chartered on October 18 with 35 members, the Rotary Club of Vientiane is part of District 3360. The Rotary Club of Chiangmai Thin-Thai-Ngam, Thailand, sponsored the charter of the new club.

Laos is a landlocked, Southeast Asian country of 6.4 million people, bordered by Vietnam, Cambodia, Thailand, Myanmar, and China.

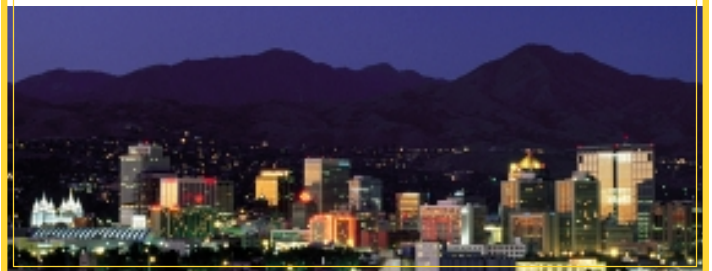

The Rotary World Peace Scholarship offers 70 individuals the opportunity to study international studies and earn a two-year master's level degree in peace and conflict resolution at one of the Rotary Center's contracted seven universities worldwide.

TWO RI SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

2008-2009 ROTARY FOUNDATION AMBASSADORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Applications for the scholarship are now available. Applications should be sent to Rochester Rotary. Local deadline is March 23, 2007.

This scholarship, designed to further international understanding and goodwill, provide for study for

one year in one of the 162 countries and 35 geographical regions where Rotary clubs are located. Some 1200 scholarships will be available from clubs worldwide.

This scholarship is for one academic year abroad and provides funding for round-trip transportation, tuition and fees, room, board, necessary educational supplies, and language training up to a maximum award of \$26,000 or its equivalent.

Rotarians and relatives of Rotarians cannot apply for this scholarship.

ANOTHER ROTARY OPPORTUNITY FRIENDSHIP EXCHANGE – SWEDEN – AUSTRALIA

This program gives Rotarians and spouses the opportunity to experience other cultures firsthand by participating in visits with Rotarians and spouses from other countries as we exchange team visits. Teams consist of about 8 to 12 persons. Preferences for outgoing teams are given to those who have hosted teams, but those who have not hosted are eligible to be on an outgoing team and are encouraged to apply. Single Rotarians are most welcome to be team members or to host visiting team members.

Sweden - Our district will be sending a team to southern Sweden (Malmo area) from May 12 to May 25, and they are currently taking applications for team members. Applications are due by February 15.

Australia – Our district will be hosting a RFE team from Australia from June 23 through July 5, 2007 and later – likely in March 2008 – we will be sending a team to District 9790 which is in Victoria and New South Wales (including part of the City of Melbourne)
